

CHSA STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Bible is our standard and our highest source for establishing a code of dress for our children. (1 Peter 3:3-5, 1 Timothy 2:9-10). The mode of dress provides an excellent opportunity for parents to exercise leadership in this vital area that is often left to fad, friends, or happenstance. Modesty is the key. The Administrator and school board has established the following standards for Crossroads Home School Academy:

1. Uniform Spirit Shirts are to be worn at Friday School.
2. Pants, Jeans and Shorts must be free of holes.
3. Shorts & Skirts must be longer than your fingertips or no more than 4in above the knee.
4. Capri's are acceptable.
5. Underwear should not be visible at any time.
6. Boy's pants and shorts must not be oversized or baggy and must be able to stay up at the waist.
7. Jackets must be free from skulls or any offensive logos.
8. No hats may be worn in the classrooms. Hats should be plain or have logos from a sports team or Christian design. No offensive logos.
9. Closed toe shoes are required. No flip-flops, high heels or platforms.
10. Monday Classes are free dress, however students must still follow the dress code.
11. Hair is to be clean and groomed. Hair may be dyed to a natural color, i.e. blonde, light brown. Extreme colors, i.e. blue, green or pink are unacceptable, and subject to administrator's approval.
12. Earrings may only be worn by girls. They must be modest in appearance and not a distraction or hazardous.
13. Backpacks and lunch bags must be free from skulls or any offensive logos.
14. Spirit Shirts are required to be worn at some field trips. Parents will be notified in advance.

Students who are out of dress code will be sent to the office to call home and wait for the appropriate clothing.
