

## **MISSIONS TRIPS**

One of the primary goals of CCHS is to give our students the opportunity to fulfill the Great Commission... “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.” (Matthew 28: 19-20 NIV) It is also our hope that, as students come to faith in Jesus Christ, they would have a chance to put that faith into action through deeds of service (James 2:17-18).

While at CCHS, students must complete 40 hours of volunteer work, or 10 hours for each academic year, as a requirement for high school graduation. We encourage each student to pray about his/her involvement in a service opportunity or missions trip that “...you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God.” (Colossians 1:10 NIV)
