CCSH offers a hybrid experience of home education by mixing home and campus learning!

We follow the Crossroads Christian Church model for being passionately committed to Christ, His Cause and His Community.

**Christ:** Leading children to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ through Christ-centered programs specifically designed for homeschooling families.

**Cause:** Partnership with parents in their home educating journey by providing mentorship and accountability in curriculum, record keeping, planning and homeschool management.

**Community:** Regularly scheduled activities, events, and small groups build community.

**We welcome families who desire the freedom to home educate privately and exclusively with us; however, dual enrollment is prohibited.**

### LEVEL 1 - TRADITIONAL HOMESCHOOL:

- \* Available to students K-12th grade.
- \* At home 5 days per week.
- \* K-5th grade students may participate in after school intramural sports.
- \* 4-8th grade students may join travel sports teams and compete against neighboring Christian Schools.
- \* Affidavit will be filed with the State of California.
- \* Record keeping forms must be turned in quarterly, including lesson plans, progress reports, and attendance.
- \* Student files will be maintained by Administration.
- \* Required participation in Back to School Night and quarterly Parent-Administration meetings.
- \* Optional curriculum counseling.
- \* Quarterly Field Trips.
- \* High School students may choose one of four academic paths: Basic, Early Grad, College Prep, or Dual Credit. See website or administration for details.

### LEVEL 2 - INTEGRATED HOMESCHOOL:

- \* Available only to students grades K-6th.
- \* At home 4 days per week, on campus 1 day per week for “Wednesday School”.
- \* “Wednesday School” will include PE, Art, Chapel, Music, Library Time, Computer Lab, and a lunch break.
- \* Uniforms are required for “Wednesday School”.
- \* K-5th grade students may participate in after school intramural sports.
- \* 4-6th grade students may join travel sports teams and compete against neighboring Christian Schools.
- \* Affidavit will be filed with the State of California.
- \* Record keeping forms must be turned in quarterly, including lesson plans, progress reports, and attendance.
- \* Student files will be maintained by Administration.
- \* Required participation in Back to School Night and quarterly Parent-Administration meetings.
- \* Optional curriculum counseling.
- \* Quarterly Field Trips.

*CCSH uniforms, ID cards, sports, and events will be offered and require additional fees. CCSH students are only eligible to participate in selected CCS events. Additional fees may apply.*

### EXPLANATION OF FEES:

All homeschooling families are required to pay our annual, non-refundable fee of \$375 per student at the time of enrollment. This all-inclusive fee will cover registration, processing, record keeping, and your student’s school spirit shirt. Payment must be made in full. There will be no proration of fees for late registrants or early withdrawals. Multi-child discounts are available.

### REGISTRATION & RECORD KEEPING FEE:

- \* \$375 per student (only \$325 until June 1)
- \* \$900 per family of 3 or more

### LEVEL 2 ON CAMPUS EXPERIENCE:

- \* \$750 per student annually
- \* 10 month payment option available (\$75.00 per month)  
Monthly option requires Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

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- \* \$1950 family fee for 3+ students
- \* 10 month payment option available (\$195.00 per month)  
Monthly option requires Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)
