Below is a story from a farmer in Guatemala who, along with his whole village, has experienced the total transformation of safe water:

Our community is located in the northeast region of Guatemala, where the sun is strong and the land is very dry. The streams are dry most of the time and the closest river is seven kilometers (4.3 miles) away from our village. Our children had to collect water, where they had to climb down a cliff of slate – inhabited by poisonous snakes – to get a small container of water. This water is poisoned with pesticides and we can only use it for washing clothes and cleaning. But when we were thirsty and had nowhere to get clean water, we had no choice to drink from the stream. Our children and the elderly were gravely ill and we did not have the money to take them to the hospital or pay for transportation or medicine.

*But our prayers have been answered and the efforts of **causelife** have transformed the lives of our village. We now have clean water not just for our own families but to also share with someone that comes our way thirsty.*
