## FAQ'S REGARDING TUITION

### What is the amount that Crossroads' tuition has been increased in the past?

- From 2006-07 to 2007-08 there was a \$500.00 increase in base tuition
- From 2007-08 to 2008-09 there was a \$250.00 increase in base tuition
- From 2008-09 to 2009-10 there was no increase in base tuition
- From 2009-10 to 2010-11 there was no increase in base tuition
- From 2010-11 to 2011-12 there was a \$550.00 base tuition increase

### Why is there a change in the amount of the sibling discount?

The cost of the education for each child is the same regardless of being a first child or a sibling. In an effort to assist families financially we do offer a 10% reduction off the base tuition.

### What is the purpose of the registration fee?

To offset the cost of liability insurance, curriculum, testing materials, consumables, school wide data base, and liability insurance.

### Why must I pay a registration fee every year?

The costs listed above are incurred on an annual basis and therefore the costs must be offset through registration fees each year. As a private Christian School, we are funded totally through tuition and fees. We do not receive any government funding as public schools do, therefore the school relies on the tuition of each student to operate.

According to the website [www.ed-data.K-12.ca.us](http://www.ed-data.K-12.ca.us) the cost to educate a child in the state of California during the 2007-08 school year was \$9706 per student.
