March is the last month to grow your scrip credit to apply to this year's tuition. In April, we will send home a reduction notice letting you know how much you have accrued from April 1st (of last year) through March 31st. This amount is to be deducted from your **May (final) tuition payment**. If you are on EFT, it will be automatically deducted. Refund checks will be issued if your tuition was paid in full or your credit exceeds your student billing balance. A credit on account may also be arranged. For accounting purposes, a credit will not be issued if it was less than \$5.00 for the year. All purchases made after March 31st will start accumulating for next year's tuition.

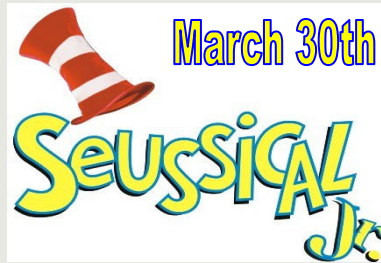
