Your **final tuition reduction notice** will be coming home sometime this week. It will reflect the amount you have accrued from April 1st (of last year), through March 31st. This amount is to be deducted from your May (final) tuition payment. If you are on EFT, it will be automatically deducted. Refund checks will be issued if your tuition was paid in full or your credit exceeds your student billing balance. For accounting purposes, a credit will not be issued if it was less than \$5.00.
