**Exciting News about VISA gift cards:** After months of research into the Credit Card Act, Great Lakes is pleased to offer a special **Promotional Visa Card** for a limited time, with a 2% non-profit rebate. This new promotional card will be available until mid-March 2011, in \$25 and \$50 denominations.

As you know, the Promotional Visa Card is great for scrip families to use at retailers that don't currently participate in scrip, or for services such as car repairs, visits to the dentist, and more. These cards are good at any location that accepts the Visa Credit Card.
