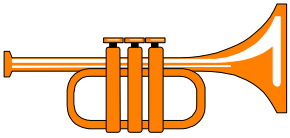

CROSSROADS TALENT SHOW MARCH 30, 2012 GUIDELINES



We are looking for a variety of acts (20-22 total) to perform at our Talent Show. This is a fund-raiser for our Performing Arts Department. Acts will be chosen by an audition panel on Tuesday, February 28th, after school in our chapel (3:00-4:30pm).

1. Permission slips signed by a parent are due at auditions (February 28th). All lyrics must be printed out and attached to the permission slip (even if you are doing a dance).
2. Each act will be previewed for appropriateness and to choose a variety of acts and ages. Your talent does not need to be perfected for auditions, however, students should be able to demonstrate to the panel that their act will be "show worthy."
3. We will provide the sound system, and a sound technician. Students must provide their own costumes, props, music, etc.
4. Practice makes perfect and must be done on your own time.
5. All acts chosen to perform at the talent show will be previewed in March, date and time to be determined. All acts should be perfected and ready to go by this date. This will be a dress rehearsal.

CRITERIA FOR PERFORMERS

1. Please make talent selections in keeping with Godly values and moral decency.
2. Music selections must be age appropriate. We encourage students to choose songs that do not talk about romantic love or adult subjects. Vocal soloists must have accompaniment tapes with no voices.
3. Students may only participant in 1 act unless you are doing another act with a group.
4. Each act should be no longer than 3 minutes.
5. Costumes should be in keeping with our dress code.



CATEGORIES

1. Vocal (Solo or group).
2. Dance (includes tap, ballet, jazz, hip hop gymnastics, etc.)
3. Musical instruments (a keyboard is available at church. All other instruments must be supplied by performer).
4. Variety [juggling, magic tricks, karate, puppets, lip-sync, baton, recitation or readers theater, comedy routines, dog acts, etc.

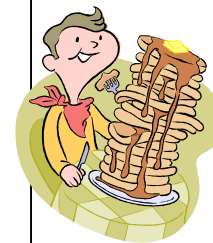
