To apply for admission, please follow the instructions for each item below.
**** Please note child must be 5 years old by September 1st for Kindergarten consideration ****

HOMESCHOOL LEVEL 1 APPLICATION PROCESS

- STUDENT APPLICATION:**
Parents and/or guardians must fill out the **application form** for all incoming students.
- GRADES / TRANSCRIPTS**
Parents/guardians must provide the applicant's most current **report card** (grades K-6) or **transcript** (grades 7-12).
- ESSAY**
Students entering **grades 6-12** are asked to write an essay about why they are interested in homeschooling with Crossroads Christian Schools.

HOMESCHOOL LEVEL 2 APPLICATION PROCESS

Available openings are determined following priority enrollment of currently enrolled students, siblings, and affiliate church members. As openings in Level 2 Wednesday School can be limited, applicants are encouraged to apply by June 1st. Students may be admitted during the school year if openings are available. Class placement is pending available space, and is not confirmed until an applicant completes the admission procedures, and the school receives all completed registration and tuition agreement forms, along with any applicable registration fees.

- STUDENT APPLICATION:**
Parents and/or guardians must fill out the **application form** for all incoming students.
- GRADES / TRANSCRIPTS**
Parents/guardians must provide the applicant's most current **report card** (grades K-6) or **transcript** (grades 7-12).
- REFERENCES (K-12th grade)**
 1. **Personal Reference** - Request a reference, from a non-family member that knows the applicant, using our **personal reference form**. An ideal reference would be someone who has observed the student regularly, perhaps in a social or learning environment.
 2. **School Reference** - If transferring from a school/classroom environment, have the current School Official release Student's Information and answer questioner.
- ESSAY**
Students entering **grades 6-12** are asked to write an essay about why they are interested in attending Crossroads Christian Schools.
- SCHOOL TOUR**
Parents and students may schedule a tour of the Level 2 Wednesday School program.

HOMESCHOOL ACCEPTANCE & REGISTRATION OF APPLICANTS (ALL LEVELS)

- Please schedule a meeting with the Homeschool Administrator to submit and review all documents. At that time you will be notified of your acceptance. After notification of acceptance, students will be offered enrollment (or waitlisted, based on Level 2 Wednesday School availability and date). Registration is not guaranteed or complete until you have met with the student account representative and all registration materials, financial/tuition agreements/payments have been submitted and finalized.
